

Thirty-four percent (34%) of graduates, one year outported that they did not haven student loan debt for their Cayugeducation.



Graduates were asked if their current salary was sufficient to meet a loan payment. Of the 49 responses (ifty-nine percent (59%) reported that their current salary was sufficient to meet their loan payment. Forty-one percent (1%) indicated that their current salary was not sufficient.
